

Wolves Classic Invitational Swim Meet

Friday, September 18, 2009—Diving—use separate diving entry

ENTRY DEADLINE IS FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 11, 2009 AT 9:00 PM

Hosted by: Chandler High School Aquatics
Location: Chandler High School Aquatic Center, 350 N. Arizona Ave. Chandler, AZ (The aquatic center is located north west of the main campus and can be accessed from Erie Street.)

Course: Outdoor, two 25 yard (8) eight lane courses, non-turbulent lane lines, Colorado start and semi-automatic timing system with scoreboard. Separate warm down area will be available throughout the meet. AIA warm-up/warm down procedures will be enforced.

Eligibility:

1. Open to any Arizona High School athlete currently participating with an Arizona high school team meeting AIA eligibility and any out of state high school team athletes whose participation has been approved by AIA.
2. Only the fastest 32 female and 32 male athletes will seeded into the 500 freestyle (4 heats).

Rules:

1. The current AIA Rules of Competitive Swimming and Diving will govern.
2. The AIA controlled meet warm-up procedure will be enforced. **Feet first entry into the warm up lanes will be enforced. Dive entries only in lanes specifically designated by the referee during warm up.**
3. All events are pre-seeded, timed final events.
4. Only the fastest 32 women and 32 men plus two alternate swimmers will be seeded into the 500 free. Psych sheets will be posted at www.chsswimanddive.netfirms.com on Sunday, September 13, 2009. Coaches of swimmers that are dropped from this event due to the entry limits will be allowed to add the dropped swimmer into another event, provided team entry limits are not exceeded. Coaches must notify Barb Mozdzen at brmozdzen@gmail.com by Monday, September 14, 2009 at 9 pm of the desired change for the dropped swimmer.
5. Swimmers must positively check-in for the 500 free with the Clerk of Course by the start of the session in order to swim the event. Alternates MAY swim if all of the top 32 swimmers do not check in.
6. Entry times must be the swimmers best Short Course time or NT (no time) for that event. You may use a previous year's time for entry purposes.
7. Each TEAM is limited to FOUR (4) swimmers per individual event. All swimmers are limited to a maximum of FOUR (4) events (individual plus relay) for the meet, with a maximum of TWO (2) individual events. Example: swimmers may swim TWO (2) individual events and TWO (2) relay events **or** ONE (1) individual event and THREE (3) relay events as a maximum entry limit. Diving counts as ONE (1) individual event.
8. Time trials will not be offered at this meet.
9. It is the intent that this meet will meet eligibility requirements as a state qualifying meet, but cannot be guaranteed. Coaches of swimmers who achieve a state meet qualifying time at this meet are responsible for submitting the proper paperwork to the meet director at the end of the meet, and for sending the paperwork in to the AIA individual responsible for tracking the outside qualifying times.
10. **Diving**—will be 6 dives. Required dive is 201 Back dive. Girls will dive first, then boys. Please clearly note your Team Name, coach with contact information and gender of the athlete on your dive entry.

Schedule: **Diving** on Friday, September 18, 2009 Gates open at 8:00 AM. No early tents.
Girls Warm up: 9:00 AM, Coach meeting at 10:00 AM, Girls Meet Starts 10:30 AM
Boys Warm up: 1:00 PM or after conclusion of girls diving, which ever is later.
Boys Meet Starts 2:00 PM or after 1 hour warm up time, which ever is later.

Swimming on Saturday, September 19, 2009. Gates open at 8:00 AM. No early tents.
Warm up: 9:00 AM, Coach meeting at 10:00 AM, Meet Starts 10:30 AM

Entries: Entries must be received by Friday September 11, 2009 by 9:00 PM.

SWIMMING ENTRIES—All entries MUST be submitted electronically. Paper entries will not be accepted. **NO late entries or deck entries will be accepted.** There are two methods of entering this meet.

1. **Hytek Team Manager or Team Manager Lite.** If you utilize Hytek Team Manager or Team Manager Lite, the Hytek entry files may be downloaded from the CHS website. <http://www.chsswimanddive.netfirms.com> Please email entries to brmozdzen@gmail.com by Friday September 11, 2009 at 9:00 PM
2. **Direct Athletics Online Entry Website.** Entries may be submitted using the Direct Athletics website. Please go to www.directathletics.com and log in using the user ID and password that you used for Regionals last fall. Entries close on Friday September 11, 2009 at 9:00 PM. Please note that if you make changes to an entry before the deadline, YOU MUST SAVE THE CHANGES before exiting. Print out your entries, and verify that all changes were accepted.

DIVING ENTRIES—Entries must be received by Friday September 11, 2009 at 9:00 PM. Paper entries for diving will be accepted. Include TEAM NAME, COACH CONTACT INFORMATION, ATHLETE NAME and GENDER, and DIVES in correct order. Please separate divers by gender on the entry. Entries should be emailed to Dianne Grayson Grayson.Dianne@Chandler.k12.az.us before the entry deadline. Alternately, entries may be FAXED to 480-224-9079. For Dive questions, please contact Dianne Grayson at 480-812-7849. Do not utilize the Direct Athletics website for Dive Entries.

Entry Fees: \$250 per combined male and female team. \$175—either male **or** female team. Entry fees must be received by Tuesday September 15, 2009 or your team will NOT be seeded into the meet. If your team has fewer than 5 swimmers, please contact Barb Mozdzen at 480-497-5703 for possible reduced entry fees.

Spectator Admission Fee: A spectator admission fee will be charged at the gate. Meet programs will be available for a modest charge.

Concessions: A concessions area will be available for the duration of the meet.

Parking: Free parking is available in the parking lot north of the aquatic facility. Additional free parking is available in the south lot, accessed off Chandler Boulevard at the first stoplight West of Arizona Avenue.

Scoring: The top 16 individual places will be scored. 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
Relay scoring : 40, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2

Awards: Medals will be awarded for the top 3 places in each individual event and for the top 3 places in each relay event. Distinctive awards will be awarded to the top 3 scoring men's team and top 3 scoring women's team.
